Gattinoni showcased 'Couture A La Carte' Spring-Summer 2015 Collection in Muscat



Italian couturier Maison Gattinoni presented its Haute Couture Spring-Summer 2015 Collection under the patronage of H.H. Designed by Creative Director, Guillermo Mariotto, who drew inspiration from the theme of Expo Milano 2015, 'Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life', his collection of 'Couture a la Carte' amalgamated the finest Italian tailoring with culinary artistry. Mariotto launched the versatile 'Le Joli Panier' line with this collection of tulle, organza and silk fabrics in palettes new to the Maison from menthol, currants, yellow olive oil and cinnamon to caramel, black liquorice, strawberry pink and white glacé cream.
